

Comments on assignments and retries

General comments

1. Include your full name and your section number (S7 or S17) clearly on the first page (and preferably on every page).
2. Make sure that you read assignments carefully.
3. Always explain your answers (in this case, why your circuit works).
4. Do not show your assignment to anyone who has yet had theirs approved.

General rules for retries on an assignment

1. If your assignment is not approved the first time, you will be allowed one retry, though you will be allowed at most two retries in all among assignments 2 through 6.
2. There will be a due date. You must turn in by that due date.
3. Turn in two copies of your new version, along with the old version with comments by the graders.
4. Do not talk with others in the class, just with your “instruktør” or Joan.

Rules specific to this retry

1. If your project/assignment was not approved, you should retry it with a deadline of 8:15 on Tuesday, September 20.

2. You should retry the entire assignment, taking into account all comments made by the graders. (There is one case where it specifically says to just retry the circuits and the algorithms are OK, so there is one exception to this.)
3. If you did not understand the magic trick or the technique shown in discussion section for designing circuits given a list of which inputs should lead to 1 as output, talk to your “instruktor” or Joan.
4. If your retry is not approved, you will flunk this 3 ECTS project. Talk to Joan immediately about what to do for a “re-exam” in the project.
