- Some students were encountering problems with FUSE. There are two things that are important for FUSE to work for (student) accounts with the current Ubuntu installation in the IMADA pool:
 - The file `/etc/fuse.conf` has to be readable. This was not the case and is fixed now.
 - It seems it is not possible to mount a FUSE filesystem on a mount point that resides on an NFS filesystem. But all the home directories reside on an NFS filesystem. To circumvent this problem, you can mount your FUSE filesystem on a directory that resides on the *local* harddisk. The easiest way to do this, is to change to `/tmp/` and create a directory (the mount point), where you mount your filesystem on. The `/tmp/` directory resides on the local harddisk.
